TEDxPeachtree to Return to Atlanta Bigger and Better

Successful 2009 Inaugural Event Prompts 150% Capacity Growth

ATLANTA, April 15, 2010 – After a resoundingly well-received 2009 event, TEDxPeachtree will be hosting its second annual conference on Friday, November 5, 2010 at a venue to be announced at a later date. Leaders, innovators, artists and entertainers from metro Atlanta will come together to share their ideas and visions around, “Shift,” the event’s 2010 theme.

Throughout history, shifts in the cultural, socio-economic, technological and scientific arenas have challenged the way we live, the way we think and even the way we perceive ourselves and others. The presentations at TEDxPeachtree 2010 will explore the transformative change that comes about as a result of these shifts. Last year, TEDxPeachtree hosted an audience of 100 attendees; this year, the free event will accommodate 250 attendees.

While attendee feedback was overwhelmingly positive, we will continue to listen to our audience and make the necessary adjustments so that we can again exceed their high expectations for TEDxPeachtree. As an example, we plan to facilitate even more opportunities to interact with speakers and among attendees this year.”
